TEMPORARY LIQUOR LICENSE

A license authorizing the sale of intoxicating liquor for consumption on the premises may be issued to any church, school, civic, service, fraternal, veteran, political or charitable club or organization for the sale of such intoxicating liquor at a picnic, bazaar, fair or similar gathering. The license shall be issued only for the day or days designated therein, but in no case shall such a license be issued to any one (1) club or organization for more than seven (7) days during any calendar year. For each such license issued, the licensee shall pay the sum of one dollar (\$1.00).
