- If you are not speaking, please mute yourself via your phone mute or the Zoom application muting option.

- Press *6 to mute or unmute your line. If you would like to make a comment during the meeting, press *9 to enable the "raise hand" feature.
- Once the Clerk calls on you, unmute and identify yourself when you speak so others know who is talking and so we can correctly identify you in the meeting minutes.
