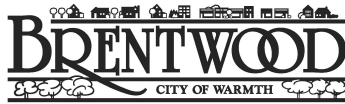

The online meeting is hosted through a remote conferencing service called Zoom, which offers audio and/or video conferencing. If you use a computer, you may need to download a browser extension. If you use a mobile device, it may prompt you to install the Zoom app.

Citizens are encouraged to participate in the following options.

1. Video Livestream — Watch a live video broadcast of the meeting. Click the link join the webinar:

- Residents who join via this link will have the opportunity to speak during the public comments portion of the meeting, as scheduled on the agenda.
- Pick a quiet spot with no background noise. You must have a working microphone (either built in or plugged in) in order to speak during the meeting. A corded cellphone-type combination of earbuds with microphone produces the best results.
- To participate during the public comments, click the "raise hand" button.
- Once the Clerk calls on you, unmute and identify yourself when you speak so others know who is talking and so we can correctly identify you in the meeting minutes.
- If you are not speaking, please mute yourself via your phone mute or the Zoom application muting option.

2. Teleconference — Call in to the meeting by dialing 301-715-8592 /// Webinar ID: 828 0389 9675. Press \*6 to mute or unmute your line. If you would like to make a comment during the meeting, press \*9 to enable the "raise hand" feature.

- Once the Clerk calls on you, unmute and identify yourself when you speak so others know who is talking and so we can correctly identify you in the meeting minutes.
