MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

Mayor Christopher Thornton called the special meeting to order at 7:07 pm in the Board Council Room of Brentwood City Hall located at 2505 S. Brentwood Blvd., Brentwood, MO 63144 and immediately led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Members present constituted a quorum. Also present were City Clerk/Administrator Bola Akande, City Attorney Kevin O’Keefe, and Deputy City Clerk Octavia Pittman.

Motion was made by Alderman Leahy and seconded by Alderman Plufka to amend Bill No 6053 adding the correct statute reference in Section 1 to 210.201 from 215.201. **Roll Call:** Alderman Kramer – yes; Alderman Leahy – yes; Alderman Lochmoeller – yes; Alderman Manestar – absent; Alderman Plufka – yes; Alderman Saunders – yes; Alderman Slusser – absent; Alderman Toohey – yes; **MOTION PASSED.**

Bill No. 6053.1 – An Ordinance Amending Section 215.1330 And 215.1340 Relating To Prohibitions Against Sex Offenders And Certain Facilities Being In Proximity To Child Care Facilities And Schools – 2nd Reading

Attorney O’Keefe read Bill #6053 by title only. Alderman Kramer provided the synopsis, “this bill is for an ordinance amending section 215.1330 and 215.1340 relating to prohibitions against sex offenders and certain facilities being in proximity to child care facilities and schools. Brentwood ordinances and state law have long had regulations intended to protect children from convicted sex offenders and violent criminals. The Board of Aldermen believes it is appropriate to re-examine and expand those protections as hereinafter provided in order to better achieve the protections these regulations promote. Alderman Leahy made a motion to perfect Bill #6053 into ordinance form. Motion seconded by Alderman Plufka. After questions, it was clarified that this legislation is part of a more comprehensive effort to improve the city’s ordinances and to allow the control of the types of operations within the city. **Roll Call:** Alderman Kramer – yes; Alderman Leahy – yes; Alderman Lochmoeller – yes; Alderman Manestar – absent; Alderman Plufka – yes; Alderman Saunders – yes; Alderman Slusser – absent; Alderman Toohey – yes; **MOTION PASSED.**

BILL #6053.1 IS HEREBY PASSED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMAN AND UPON SIGNATURE BY THE MAYOR BECOMES ORDINANCE #4706.
