The St. Louis Metropolitan Area Amnesty Program began in 2000. Better Family Life, as a regional leader in workforce development for youth and adults, experienced firsthand the frustration, stress, and demoralizing impact of not being able to gain employment due to outstanding traffic warrants. The model expanded in 2006 to cover all misdemeanor warrants and again in 2012 to include child support warrants. In 2015, we expanded once again to include “Ask an Attorney” information sessions for those whose needs went beyond the focus of our three day event.

The Process

- Step 1: Citizen attends Amnesty Program & Legal Expo on August 5, 9, or 12th.
- Step 2: Citizen completes workshop segment and receives a voucher
- Step 3: Citizen reports to appropriate municipality with voucher to obtain new court date

AMNESTY PROCEDURES FOR BRENTWOOD MUNICIPAL COURT

**August 7, 2017 through September 25, 2017
Monday through Friday, 9:00 am to 4:30 pm**

1. Person charged, or family member/friend, can appear at the violations bureau window during normal business hours with a voucher from Better Family Life.
2. Person must post \$100.00 bond for all warrants to be lifted and a future court date to be given.

OR

The \$100.00 can be applied to existing fines and costs after warrants are lifted and person can be placed on a payment plan.
