

2017 Annual Budget Planning

The 2017 Annual Budget process began on July 1st, with preliminary budget discussions with the Board of Aldermen to set goals and parameters that will guide the development of the budget.

August - A Citizen Budget Forum will go before the Ways & Means Committee on Thursday, August 11th, discussing specific goals and priorities for consideration in the 2017 budget. At this meeting the City Administrator will present year to date city financial analysis.

September - The Board of Aldermen will hold a public hearing on September 19th (with a tentative second public hearing on September 28th if needed) to adopt and certify by ordinance, the 2016 property tax rates, to be submitted to St. Louis County by October 1.

November / December – The Board of Aldermen will hold a public hearing where the FY 2017 Operating and Capital Improvement Budget will be presented for approval at either the November 21st Board of Aldermen meeting or the December 1st Board of Aldermen meeting. The exact date has yet to be determined.
