City of Brentwood Offering Free Self-Defense Classes for Brentwood Residents

Brentwood, Missouri – August 29, 2018 – Brentwood residents have an opportunity to learn self-defense techniques during two free classes in September.

The Escape and Evasion Training course provides insight into the principles of avoidance, escape and evasion. Participants will learn techniques for avoiding pending aggression by becoming aware of certain threat cues, and countering and escaping from escalating levels of physical threats.

The Confrontation Avoidance and Safety course is designed for older adults. Participants will learn about principles for avoiding violent confrontations and techniques to increase awareness of potential encounters. This course includes an optional physical component teaching a series of no impact, no stress techniques to increase balance and prepare attendees to survive an attack with minimal injury; physical exertion is minimal to participate.

Instructors for both classes are Tom Jost, security consultant and former Florissant, Missouri police officer; and Tscharna Senn, security consultant and former Gainesville, Florida police officer.

The City of Brentwood is covering the cost of these classes to offer them for free to Brentwood residents.
