Priority registration weeks for Fall 2020 only applies to players when remaining on their Winter 2020 assigned team. Six teams (with a ten-player minimum, one goaltender roster) will be assembled after the registration period is over and rosters/game schedules will be sent to players *tentatively on September 28th*. All participants must be 18 years of age or older to play. Brentwood Parks and Recreation staff reserves the right to approve or remove any player in any division at any time. Fees are due at time of registration and may be paid during normal business hours in person at Brentwood Ice Rink or over the phone (314)-963-8684 with credit card (with registration form sent via email). Registration is not complete until fees are paid. USA Hockey Registration is required for participation.

HOLD HARMLESS WAIVER, COVID WAIVER:

I, the undersigned participant, on behalf of myself, my heirs, legatees and assigns, hereby agree to indemnify, save and hold harmless the City of Brentwood or any of their agents, representatives, employees, representatives of the Missouri Ice Hockey Officials Association, or assigns, for my health, safety or injury and or disability arising out of or resulting from participation in this program. I also authorize any photos taken of myself, the participant, to be used in any publicity or promotion materials by the department. By signing this contract, participant declares that they have read, understand and agree to comply with the HOLD HARMLESS POLICY AND PROVISION FOR INDEMNITY: In consideration of being allowed to enter upon the land and/or facilities owned or operated by the City of Brentwood or its affiliates, participant agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City of Brentwood together with its elected and appointed officers, employees, agents, successors and assigns collectively here referred to as RELEASES, and each of them from any claim, cause of action, loss, liability, damage, expense or cost, including attorney's fees, incurred or initiated due to or in any way arising from the presence of the participant or the participant's agents employees or guests in or upon the land or facilities owned or operated by the City of Brentwood or its affiliates caused by the negligence of the RELEASES or otherwise. Participant expressly agrees that this indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the state of Missouri; and if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
