The Public Works Committee meeting will be conducted in a virtual format. The Council Chambers at City Hall will not be open to the public.

- The online meeting is hosted through a remote conferencing service called Zoom, which offers audio and/or video conferencing. If you use a computer, you may need to download a browser extension. If you use a mobile device, it may prompt you to install the Zoom app.

- Citizens are encouraged to participate in the following options.

1. Video Livestream — Watch a live video broadcast of the meeting. Click the link join the webinar: <https://us02web.zoom.us/j/82587835788> You will have the opportunity to speak during the public comments portion of the meeting, as scheduled on the agenda.

- Pick a quiet spot with no background noise. You must have a working microphone (either built in or plugged in) in order to speak during the meeting. A corded cellphone-type combination of earbuds with microphone produces the best results.
- To participate during the public comments, click the "raise hand" button.
- Once the Clerk calls on you, unmute and identify yourself when you speak so others know who is talking and so we can correctly identify you in the meeting minutes.
- If you are not speaking, please mute yourself via your phone mute or the Zoom application muting option.

2. Teleconference — Call in to the meeting by dialing 301-715-8592 /// Webinar ID: 82587835788. Press *6 to mute or unmute your line. If you would like to make a comment during the meeting, press *9 to enable the "raise hand" feature.

- Once the Clerk calls on you, unmute and identify yourself when you speak so others know who is talking and so we can correctly identify you in the meeting minutes.

3. Email — You also may email comments to the Deputy City Clerk no later than 24 hours from the time of the meeting. Submit public comments to Kelle Silvey, ksilvey@brentwoodmo.org.

- Public comments, provided they comply with the City's guidelines, will be read during the meeting, made a part of the official record of the meeting, and made accessible to the public online following the meeting.
