During the month of April we had so many submissions for Officer of the Month, which is a true testament to the men and women of the BPD and their exceptional service to the community.

In mid-April officers Wilcox, Clark, and Habibovic worked together to identify a subject responsible for the theft of more than \$8,000 worth of cigarettes. Their investigation not only located and recovered the stolen property but also located and seized a small amount of narcotics from the suspect, who was on Probation/Parole for a previous offense.

Charges were issued against the suspect for felony stealing, possession of narcotics, and trespassing. Additionally, Probation/Parole was contacted and advised they would be revoking the suspect's probation based on this case.

Thanks to these officers, their enthusiasm, passion, drive, and perseverance, a career criminal was held accountable for several felonies. These are just three of the many Brentwood Police Officers who serve this community every day. If you see them on the road, be sure to thank them for their hard work.

Manchester Closure

On May 2nd the Manchester closure began and since then our officers have been extremely proactive in their efforts to address an increase in traffic in the Cecelia neighborhood. Halfway through the month our officers have conducted nearly 100 traffic stops in the neighborhood and issued more than 60 citations. Both police and residents are members of this community, and as a community we have a responsibility to keep our roads and our children safe.
